













Mollisia cf. olivascens SW20

Substrate: Decorticated, well-weathered and insect-eaten wood.

Location: Clyne valley cycle track, Swansea,

Wales, UK.

Lat/long: 51.613449, -4.028337

Notes: Apothecia very large (up to 5 mm diam.). Morphologically resembles *Mollisia olivascens* and *Haglundia perelegans*. Extremely strong yellow diffusible KOH reaction, and IKI+. Long hairs (50-90 x 3.5 μm) composed on multiple brown-pigmented cells (10-20 x 3.5 μm) developing from the margin, sides and lower flanks of apothecia.
